HOME RUN HITTER lost momentum when checked on the heels of BOAT RIDE near the three and a half furlong marker, regrouped and quickly gained three wide nearing the quarter pole, took over in upper stretch then drew off under a drive. ECHO D'OR was taken to rate, saved ground into the lane, angled out a bit, rallied between rivals leaving the sixteenth marker and was clear for the place. SHE'S THE TICKET was hustled along on the turn, came three wide for the drive and lacked a solid response. BOAT RIDE sprinted clear, set the pace towards the inside, was overtaken in upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong. CITY FIRE chased the pace racing three to four wide and tired in upper stretch. BLUE HARMONY was always outrun.
