UNDERCOVER assumed the early lead, set the pace along the rail and pulled away under brisk urging. TAMAYO , unhurried early, was steadied lacking room near the quarter pole, swung wide in upper stretch and rallied. CARNIE'S DANCER broke slowly, advanced three wide on the backstretch and weakened in the drive. NO HALOS HERE saved ground stalking the pace and weakened. FLOAT AND STING prompted the pace outside the winner and gave way. MADAME X SKI raced wide entering the stretch and stopped.
