MOE'S MON , unhurried early, swung very wide entering the stretch, closed determinedly and was along in time. OUTSTANDER , hustled along early, prompted the pace outside SAFE IN THE U S A, gained a clear advantage in midstretch and weakened late. PRIVATE OPENING lacked speed, raced in the two path and rallied. SAFE IN THE U S A showed speed along the rail and gave way. DOC'S ALLOWANCE raced along the rail and gave way. CAPTAIN CHESSIE , four wide, chased the pace and gave way.
