WALLOP disputed the pace along the inside under some rating, shook clear after six furlongs, opened up when called upon in upper stretch and maintained a safe margin under a drive. CATS TOWER , four to five wide nearing the first turn, angled in some for the run down the backstretch, moved closer leaving the far turn, swung out four wide nearing the lane and finished willingly. SWEEP UP rated close up while saving ground, got through along the rail in upper stretch but failed to mount a rally. TELL NO TALES , four wide the first turn, continued wide to the lane and gave way. WAGE A PENNY disputed the pace outside of the winner and gave way in upper stretch. STEPIT was floated out a bit entering the first turn, stalked the dueling leaders while between rivals early, was called upon leaving the far turn and gave way.
