SQUEEZ BLOSSOM quickly went clear, dictated the pace along the inside under rating, opened up a commanding lead in mid stretch and cruised home winning handily. UNREPENTANT , between rivals into the far turn, advanced four wide leaving the five sixteenths pole, finished willingly but was no match. HAUNTED RIVER , close up early while saving some ground, waited briefly mid way on the final turn, advanced between rivals into the stretch but lacked a solid closing response. KISSIN SHARP failed to menace. CASEY JEAN , between rivals around the first turn, stalked the pace and gave way in upper stretch. WYE RIVER RUGRAT stumbled at the break, lost ground five wide leaving the far turn and weakened. BRILLIANT JEWEL , four wide into the first turn, stalked the pace off the rail and faltered.
