TORCH THE HALLS went clear early, dictated the pace along the inside, was set down in upper stretch and edged away under a drive. JIM THIRDS BOLERO stalked the pace along the inside, was put to urging mid way on the final turn and continued willingly to gain the place. KISSIN' JACK was sent up between rivals early, stalked the winner two wide, came three wide for the drive and gave way grudgingly. ALL THINGS FRENCH , unhurried early, saved ground into the far turn, angled out but lacked a solid bid. PINKY PIZWAANSKI , well placed early, moved closer into the far turn, angled out and gave way. RACE ON GREEN , three wide early, chased the pace for a half mile and faltered.
