Footnotes

BAR FLY stalked the pace three wide, came four wide for the drive, lodged a bid leaving the furlong marker, took command near the sixteenth pole and edged away under a drive. HEART OFA CHAMPION was sent up between rivals, dueled two wide on the turn, came three wide for the drive, gained a slim lead past the eighth pole and battled gamely. RICO ENDS WELL dueled inside, drifted off the rail into the stretch, battled to the sixteenth pole then weakened a bit. GEM'S WAGER lacked room along the inside, altered course in the lane and came up empty. ERNABEL, outrun early, ranged up five wide into the stretch then flattened out in the final furlong. LUCKY VALID advanced between rivals near the three eighths pole, clipped heels when full of run approaching the quarter pole, dropped back and failed to recover. ROBIN DES TUNE came in at the break bumping LUCKY VALID, lacked speed and weakened.
