SENSIBLY CHIC , three wide, raced on her left lead through the stretch, closed nicely and drove clear. WALLOP chased the pace two wide, gained the lead near the sixteenth pole and gave way grudgingly. THERMAL ABLASION , two wide on the turn, swung to the four path in upper stretch and rallied. BRIGHT GOLD , sent to the front, set the pace along the rail and gave way. TIGHT SPIN , no factor, raced along the rail. DOUBLE SCOOP , wide, gave way. BRONZE ABE hopped and was rank leaving the starting gate, raced very wide and was no factor. REGAL 'N BOLD , outrun, raced in the three path.
