Footnotes

SILMARIL , well handled early while saving ground, moved closer nearing the far turn, angled out, advanced between rivals leaving the three furlong marker, cruised up four wide in hand approaching the quarter pole, struck the top in upper stretch, opened up when roused, drifted out some in deep stretch and held sway under a drive. POUR IT ON , unhurried early, saved ground around the final turn while advancing, angled out five wide in upper stretch, angled back to the inside near the sixteenth marker and finished gamely. CHRUSCIKI stalked the pace while off the rail, lodged a mild bid nearing the quarter pole, lacked a solid stretch response but did manage to save the show while between rivals. BLIND CANYON , forwardly placed while saving ground, steadied briefly entering the far turn, continued inside to upper stretch, swung out leaving the eighth pole and finished willingly. HUNCA MUNCA cleared early, set the pace along the inside, was collared nearing the quarter pole and gave way grudgingly in the final furlong. JENNASILPRINCESS failed to menace. TRUE SENSATION , allowed to settle, angled six wide for the drive but lacked a late response. SWEEP UP never threatened. FREE DIP , rated back early, stalked the pace three wide and dropped back nearing the quarter pole.
