GLOBAL STORM was keen on speed early and dueled CUVEE CITY to the turn, came two wide to the stretch, responded when set down and kicked away to mid stretch then was all out to hold. BARDY chased the leaders to the turn, raced three then four wide to the stretch and closed steadily but was too late. RATHGAR was outrun to the turn, raced two wide to the stretch then could not impact the top two. CUVEE CITY broke alertly and dueled outside the winner while three wide to the stretch but was tiring through the final furlong. BRONWYN'S BREW stalked the pace to the turn then was outrun while four wide to the stretch and gave way. FRISCO BOUND was very green in the opening quarter and fell well behind then did not recover. GLOBAL APPEAL was outsprinted to the turn, also raced four deep to the stretch but never rallied. RADITCH had no speed and was not a factor.
