WITH RESPECT broke with the leaders then took back just off them, commenced her bid four wide on the upper turn, challenged three wide into the lane, took command a furlong out but was all out to hold. RAINBOW'S WAY raced up inside after the break to set a pressured pace, disposed of RAINBOW WEAVE into the lane but was challenged by the winner entering the lane and gave way grudgingly. RIGHTEOUSLY settled early, advanced four wide on the turn but flattened out in the lane. RAINBOW WEAVER pressed the pace two wide to the stretch and gave out. SHEZA CARCHY raced close up early but gave way three wide on the turn. ELEGANT LOOQ broke alertly but was shuffled back in tight quarters at the five eighths pole, saved ground to the stretch but did not respond. ADANCE FOR ADELE pressed the pace early two wide and came up empty.
