TWO STEP SATURDAY dueled from off the rail to the stretch, kicked away to mid stretch then was all out to hold. TOP BOSS was outprinted to the turn, bid three wide, let SKYY UP DRY go by him then swung out eight wide into the stretch and closed steadily under strong urging. SKYY UP DRY had no speed, was asked four wide for more, swung out seven deep into the stretch and was also gaining ground steadily. COME ON DEPUTY tracked the pace to the turn, bid two wide to the stretch, got outkicked to mid stretch and finished evenly. PREACHER BOY chased the pace early, offered a good bid four wide to the stretch but lost his punch in the final furlong. ALMOST FOOLISH had no speed, raced four wide on the turn then made up ground belatedly. BRONCO WILLIE pressed the pace three wide to the stretch, got outkicked to mid stretch and tired. BIG SWIG broke a bit slow then had no speed and was not a factor. HIGH CAT stalked the pace from the rail to the stretch then gave out. AHUALULCO had no speed and was never a threat.
