Footnotes

BALLET RIBBONS showed the best speed and crossed over to save ground on the first turn, dueled with DIXIE DOT CHANCE to the half mile pole, edged away on the second turn then responded when set down and held driving. SIZZLING GOLD stalked the leaders to the half, bid three wide on the second turn, loomed boldly into the stretch then could not sustain the needed response. TOO HOT TO TOUCH had no speed, settled for a half mile, was asked for more three wide on the second turn but did not threaten in the drive. P TOWN TOPPER also had no speed, raced three wide on the second turn but came up empty in the stretch. LUCKY SPELL saved ground to no avail. KRIS ALI was three wide on the first turn, settled mid pack to the second turn then came two wide to the stretch but gave way through the lane. DIXIE DOT CHANCE attended the pace for five furlongs then gave out.
