BLINGBOY broke alertly and dueled outside YOU BETTOR BEWARE to the stretch, edged clear in mid stretch and held driving. FIREFLY BAY tracked the dueling leaders from off the rail, shifted to the three path into the stretch, responded and was gaining steadily. YOU BETTOR BEWARE set a pressured pace from the inside to the stretch and weakened. SKYRIBBON saved ground to no avail. MO PLEASURE settled early, raced well off the rail on the turn and did not respond. MAGIC OF THE MOON lacked good early speed, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to rally. HARD SLIDER broke poorly and was always outrun.
