MUNNINGS SISTER raced up after the break and gained a short lead in the opening quarter, edged clear leaving the turn and held driving. MILANIA lacked good early speed, raced three wide on the turn, angled out once in the stretch to find her stride and finished full of run. COUP DE COEUR raced close up from the outside early, had her best bid two wide near the quarter pole and slackened in the lane. TRIBAL DELIGHT was the early leader, dueled inside the winner on the turn, drifted out into the stretch and lacked a late response. KAWANI RUN had no early speed, saved ground to the stretch and went evenly late. YUMA THURMAN lacked early speed, raced two wide on the turn and did not respond. BACKWOODS BELLE stalked the pace early, was fanned four wide on the turn and came up empty. WEE HIGHLAND LASS had no speed. TACARA MUCHO flashed brief speed from the outside.
