LOOSE CASH pressed the pace to the half, responded and went up to duel for the lead on the second turn, battled through a long drive and gamely prevailed late. YES I'M SWEET tracked the pace from the rail to the second turn, lacked room behind VALID DOUBLE and was forced to wait, shifted outside that one and angled three wide into the stretch, rallied to take a short lead inside the furlong grounds but could not hold on. ENTRANCING was fanned five wide on the first turn, settled mid pack to the three eighths, rallied four wide and closed ground to engage the leaders into the stretch, remained a factor to mid stretch but weakened in the final sixteenth. SHEIK'S PRINCESS never far back for a half, rallied three wide on the second turn but could not sustain that run in the lane. VALID DOUBLE set the pace to the backstretch, tried to respond when hooked on the second turn but tired after six furlongs. SATINA broke a step slow and had no speed, swung three wide on the second turn and attempted to rally but came up empty in the drive. TONI ANN bobbled then was bumped at the start, had no speed and was not a factor. MARTINIS ATMIDNITE was allowed to settle, saved ground for six furlongs then gave out.
