KINGMAN KID was hustled to the front soon after the start, dueled with ITALIAN EXPRESS to mid turn, kicked clear and was never again challenged. WEST CORK ROUTE never far back, came four wide through the turn and rallied mildly without threatening the winner. YOUTOTMECONFUSED raced reservedly to the turn, came four wide and responded to hard urging through the drive to garner the show. THUNDERPARK off a step slow, worked forward through the backstretch and responded gamely along the rail when asked for more. MYPROMISETWOJOAN rushed soon after the start, remained close to the turn but had no response when more was needed. ITALIAN EXPRESS dueled with the winner to the middle of the turn while three wide and gave way. JUDICIAL MATTER was never a factor. DOUG'S BOY raced in the middle of the pack throughout and did not rally. SUPPLY N DEMAND also raced in the middle of the pack to mid turn and gave way.
