MISS SAND BAR was sent for speed and duelled outside horses to the turn, responded and pulled clear to mid stretch then edged away under steady pressure. TIALINGA broke alertly, attended the pace to the turn, was passed and fell back to the stretch but shifted out in upper stretch and was coming back on late. AWESOME BEGINNING had no speed, saved ground to the stretch and closed steadily in the drive. SPICY CAJUN tracked the pace from the rail to the stretch but tired in the drive. SWEET BOLD NRED stalked the leaders to the turn, rallied two wide and loomed briefly into the stretch but weakened. HIGH SILVER was well placed off the leaders to the turn but had little to offer in the drive. ASHLEY 'N ROBERT had no speed, tried to rally three wide to the stretch but came up empty. GENTLEMAN'S GIRL settled mid pack to the turn, was also three deep to the stretch and lacked a rally. ONE TRICK PONY broke awkwardly and was not a factor.
