DANCING LUTE bobbled slightly at the beginning, stalked the pace while playing 'follow the leader' to mid turn, shifted out for room, rallied between rivals, took a short lead in mid stretch then dug in determinedly to hold. CHA DA BOOM pressed the pace to the turn, was two wide to mid turn then was pushed out three deep to the stretch, tried the winner leaving mid stretch but was outgamed to the line. VICTORIA SHINES set the pace from the rail to the stretch, responded to mid stretch then tired. SOME KIND OF RIDE chased the pace to the turn, was two wide to the stretch then came up empty. STORM FLEUR had no speed and was not a factor. TRULY BEST chased the pace outside of SOME KIND OF RIDE, was three wide to the stretch but gave way through the drive.
