BO'S SECRET RUCKUS edged up two wide on the turn, rallied inside into the lane, split rivals and pulled away late. PUTAH CREEK dueled on the front end to the middle of the turn, took a short lead turning for home but could not hold off the winner when it counted. FLAME IT lagged in the early going, edged up two wide, dropped inside for the drive and closed willingly. ERMA'S FIRST LOVE dueled with PUTAH CREEK to the middle of the turn and then gradually dropped back. DOUBLE TRICKSTER race far back to the stretch and showed some late interest much too late. DONNA'S FIRST LOVE was close up to the stretch while three wide and weakened. MY ZOHEY race wide throughout and could not rally. TAHLEQUAH MAIDEN had no speed and was always last.
