BESPOKE SUIT took back at the start and lagged to the second turn, quickly circled rivals four wide to the stretch, continued to rally, took command late and won driving. FAR TO REACH set all of the pace from off the rail, finished steadily but could not match strides with the winner. TEMECULA settled early from off the rail, offered a menacing bid three wide on the second turn but flattened out in the lane. ONEINAMILLIONYOU raced unhurried from the rail early, was in tight quarters between horses on the second turn, checked and fell back. THEFUTUREISNOW tracked the pace early from the rail but steadily weakened. STRIKING OFFER was never a factor. BROADWAY ACT settled early, raced three wide to the stretch and came up empty. The rider aboard ONCEINAMILLIONYOU lodged an objection against the winner for interference on the second turn. After reviewing the incident the stewards acknowledged that ONCEINAMILLIONYOU was in tight quarters and checked on the second turn but could not assess any blame and allowed the original finish to stand.
