Footnotes

SWISS G'S broke in stride and tracked IRISH CORAL for the lead, moved up between horses once in the stretch to vie for command and proved best in a prolonged stretch battle. SLAM SLEW was permitted to settle early, advanced four wide on the turn to loom a bold factor from the outside at the furlong pole but could not get by. IRISH CORAL sprinted clear early and set all of the pace, responded in the upper stretch but gradually weakened. DO WHAT U DARE raced unhurried early, came two wide to the stretch and finished steadily. PALE OUTLAW stalked the pace from the outset, steadied sharply near the quarter pole, recovered but lacked the needed response. DEEJENERIT was well positioned early from the outside, raced three wide into the lane and weakened. STREET TITAN lagged early and failed to respond while three wide entering the lane. EASY SIX stumbled sharply at the start and fell back then saved ground but had no response. RINO U settled early, fell back on the turn then was eased in the stretch and walked off.
