GIBSON HOME RUN was bumped by MIND THE LADIES at the start then hustled up between rivals to join the pace, edged clear from the two path to the stretch then responded in the final furlong and held off ELUSIVE MOMENT late. ELUSIVE MOMENT The latter prompted the winner three wide to the stretch then finished steadily but could not catch up. A PINT FOR MARY was outspurred to the turn, came two wide to the stretch then lacked the needed late response. WHATEVER WHENEVER was on the pace to the turn, got outkicked by the winner while saving ground to the stretch and tired through the final furlong. MIND THE LADIES broke out and bumped the winner at the start then was crowded between rivals on the backstretch and had to check at the nine sixteenths, raced three wide to the stretch and failed to rally in the drive. PRIDE OF WILSHIRE tracked the pace to the turn, tried to rally from the four path to the stretch but gave way in the lane. BENJY'S PRIDE had no speed while widest and was not a factor.
