CAT WEATHER was quickly in front to set all of the pace, disposed of NATIVE SAND leaving the furlong pole to briefly draw clear then gamely held off SAYLO. SAYLO stalked the leaders from the inside, angled out once in the stretch and was steadily gaining in the final stages. NATIVE SAND prompted the winner from the outset, offered his best bid nearing the furlong pole and slackened. SUPER RAPTOR stalked the leaders from the outside, remained four wide on the turn and lacked a response. LAST MANGO INPARIS settled early, was two wide on the turn and flattened out. GENERAL ROYAL broke very slow and raced unhurried, came to the outside and closed too late. THE BARKING SHARK checked from between horses into the turn, dropped inside but failed to respond. B DAY steadied in tight quarters leaving the half mile pole, came four wide on the turn but had no rally. FLYING SINGER lacked early speed or a closing response.
