MISS MISBEHAVIN' attended the pace from between horses to the far turn, responded and pulled clear from BE LIKE MOM to the stretch, tried to resist the winner in mid stretch but was no match while holding the place. SINCEYOUWENTAWAY lagged to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch and picked up the show. BE LIKE MOM dueled for the lead for six furlongs and weakened. JENNIFERS PUB was allowed to settle while three deep for a half, remained three wide on the second turn but came up empty in the drive. FIRST CLASS CODE dueled for the lead while three wide to the second turn, appeared to switch leads unexpectedly and took a bad step mid way on the final bend then was pulled up in the stretch but walked off after crossing the finish line.
