Footnotes

TIMEINTOWN had good speed and was pace factor throughout, disposed of LADY SIPHONICA into the stretch, edged clear and was under steady pressure to the wire. KELLY'S PRINCESS stalked the pace to the turn, came two wide to the stretch, was blocked, bumped with RENTS DUE and checked at the three sixteenths then was quickly in the clear and came on but was no threat to the winner. WELCOME QUEEN hesitated in the gate and was off slow, had no speed, raced three deep to the stretch, angled in for room in upper stretch, was trying to rally along the rail but ducked out slightly in mid stretch then recovered and finished well. LADY SIPHONICA dueled for the lead inside the winner to the turn, responded to the stretch then could not keep up and weakened. SHOCKING DUNN was allowed to settle, raced two wide to the stretch, shifted out and picked off rivals without threatening. IREZA was allowed to settle, raced three wide to the stretch and was briefly a factor into the stretch but came up empty in the final furlong. DRIVING MISS HELEN had no speed, raced three wide throughout and was not a factor. RENTS DUE attended the pace to the turn, raced three wide and was still a contender to the quarter pole then bumped with KELLY'S PRINCESS in upper stretch, was off stride for a couple of strides and weakened. CONTINENTAL CALLER was outrun and settled mid pack to the turn then lugged out to mid turn and was not a factor. BOLD MARTY was always outrun.
