Footnotes

GLOBAL STARTER took command into the first turn and set all of the pace from just off the rail, responded once in the stretch and held driving after good rating. SR AUSTIN stalked the winner from the rail into the stretch, shifted out but could make no impact. SAW PERFECTION was permitted to settle early, raced two wide to the stretch and closed a minor gap. BALLESTERO was always forwardly placed and raced four wide throughout then failed to respond once in the stretch. SKY CHIEF lagged early from off the rail, was forced to rally five wide into the lane and came on too late. ANCIENT WISDOM settled early, raced three wide throughout and did not respond. HARVIN ROBINSON was forced four wide to the backstretch while in the back of the pack, moved up two wide on the second turn but had nothing left for the drive. SIERRA SEVEN pressed the winner two wide to the second turn and gave out.
