SLEW THE MAN had the best speed, set all the pace to the second turn, turned back EL GATO MALO to the stretch then kicked clear to mid stretch but was under steady urging to hold. BOLD CHIEFTAIN was allowed to the settle for a half, saved ground while advancing on the second turn then finished gamely but was too late. EL GATO MALO stumbled at the start then was hurried to press the winner to the backstretch, offered his best try two wide on the second turn but had that bid turned back and weakened in the final furlong. HONOUR THE DEPUTY chased the pace to the second turn, bid three wide to the stretch but was not a threat late. PODE IR (BRZ) tracked the pace to the half, came two wide to the stretch but failed to rally in the drive. DELIGHTFUL KISS had no speed and was well off the rail to the half, raced four wide on the second turn and also lacked a response in the stretch. AUTISM AWARENESS saved ground to the backstretch, settled to the second turn then was three wide to the stretch but was outrun through the lane.
