MOSCATO gained a short early lead, edged clear on the backstretch, maintained the advantage into the stretch, was headed by GUIDING HAND a furlong out but fought back gamely and won driving. GUIDING HAND tracked the pace from the inside, commenced his bid two wide into the lane, gained a short lead at the furlong pole but was outfinished. STORMY SURGE raced unhurried early, saved ground to the stretch, offered his best bid near the furlong pole and hung. DUNSCOMBE lagged early, came two wide on the second turn and failed to rally. SURFER DAVE settled early from off the rail, came three wide on the second turn and failed to rally. TATERTWISTER flashed speed and came up empty. RENZO SEAN stopped into the second turn then was eased in the stretch.
