WIN IT TO BE IN was quickly in front to set all of the pace, drew clear in the upper stretch then extended her advantage driving. KOOL LUCY broke a bit slow but rushed up from the rail to track the winner, could not with that rival in the stretch but held second. PEPPER CALI lacked good early speed, came three wide to the stretch but failed to reach serious contention. SLIGHTLY GAMEY broke alertly then slipped back, tried to rally three wide on the turn but lacked the needed response. BESAME MUCHO prompted the pace and gave way two wide on the turn. SNACKABLE flashed speed from the outside but was through by the three eighths pole. RULER OF THE TRIBE flashed only very brief speed.
