OURWESTCOASTGHOST had no speed, advanced inside on the turn, responded when set down for the drive and pushed to the front in the late stages. COACH BOB attended a very fast pace outside of DISTINCTIV PASSION, was outkicked while two wide to the stretch but kept to task in the final furlong and grabbed second. DISTINCTIV PASSION had sizzling speed, pushed away from COACH BOB to the stretch but was tiring through the final furlong. AL INSTANTE (CHI) was outsprinted early, chased two wide to the stretch, eased out for running room in upper stretch then eased back towards the rail leaving the furlong grounds and was gaining late. MOONSHINE BAY chased the pace to the turn, tried to rally three wide to the stretch but could not make an impact. AIN'T NO OTHER was outsprinted to the turn, also raced three wide to the stretch but tired through the drive.
