**Footnotes**

DREAMY MEETING never far back, rallied four wide to the stretch, lugged inward under right handed whipping leaving the eighth pole and closed late. REGALA dueled on the pace to the turn, responded to pressure to inch clear in mid stretch but was nailed late. MUTE MUSE was allowed to settle, waited on the turn behind horses, angled out in upper stretch, tired to split foes but had to steady when blocked by the winner and could not recover. SPEEDING STAR dueled from the rail to the stretch but had little left for the drive. O TOO KOOL stalked the pace three wide but lacked a closing response. STORMY AIR was allowed to settle but was outrun. TUDOR HALL (IRE) was always outrun. MILLS FIELD became rank and lost her action soon after the start and was always far back. CRYING FOR REAL began climbing nearing the half mile pole and also lost her action and fell back steadily. Following a steward's inquiry, DREAMY MEETING was disqualified from first to third for interference in mid stretch.
