**Footnotes**

CASE STUDY was hustled to the lead into the first turn then settled and set all of the pace from just off the rail, responded into the lane to draw well clear then had enough left to hold. R FAT MAN settled early from the rail and tracked the winner to the second turn, eased outside that rival and was closing in the late stages. COVER MAGIC was void of early speed, commenced his bid from the rail on the second turn, remained inside and closed steadily. BALLET WAY showed little. YVETT'S PRIDE stalked the winner four wide early and gave out while three wide on the second turn. DOWN BY THE LAKE had no speed and was eased in the stretch but walked off. GIDDY YAP was rank early while prompting the winner four wide to the backstretch, remained a factor to the second turn then stopped badly and was eased in the stretch but walked off.
