BARREL KNOT broke alertly, set all the pace, edged away to mid stretch then was all out to hold. MAGIC OF THE MOON was last leaving the chute, moved up when pushed along to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch then was making good progress but was too late. LORD AVALON had no speed, saved ground to the stretch then came off the rail in upper stretch, rallied and split rivals and closed steadily. OHANA SPIRIT pressed the winner to the turn, bid two then three wide to the stretch, was outkicked to mid stretch then could not make an impact late. WILLIE THE FOX tracked the pace from the two path to the stretch but lacked the needed late response. MAIDENS JUSTICE chased the winner to the turn, bid two wide to the stretch then was making up ground belatedly. TWAIN'S TITAN had no speed and was not a factor.
