SIBLE settled off the pace, made run inside to the stretch, rallied when set down and closed with a rush to nail ENCHANTED WOODS. ENCHANTED WOODS sped clear shortly after the start, widened her lead into the stretch but tired badly in the final sixteenth and was tagged late. OLYMPIC METTLE chased the pace to the stretch but lacked the needed late response. SWINGTIME MUSIC was outrun to the stretch and closed with a mild bid. FLIP 'N' BARGAIN chased the pace to the stretch and weakened. TRIAL LITTLE TASTE was not a factor. EARLY EARLY ECHO hit the gate and broke in a tangle and did not recover. SALTY BROAD was through early.
