Footnotes

WILLYCAN emerged from between horses shortly after the star to establish the lead, set all of the pace from off the rail, took his longest lead near the furlong pole then just did last. MILITARYDRESSBLUES was never far back from the outside, was fanned four wide into the lane and finished steadily to just miss. SOVEREIGN ROAD was permitted to settle early, raced two wide on the turn then finished steadily. MY TOPPER stalked the winner two wide and between horses to the stretch but lacked a closing response. NO NIBBLING raced unhurried early, angled four wide into the stretch but did not rally. CHUMASH JOE lagged to the turn, angled to the extreme outside into the lane but passed only tiring horses. DOWN RIVER ROAD tracked the winner from the rail to mid turn and gave out. SUPER SALESMAN stalked the pace three wide and between horses for a half mile then had little left. STEVE'S BOY broke sharply to the outside to be off slow and was always outrun.
