MARSHAL MARINI was well placed from the outset, commenced his bid from the three path into the stretch, quickly collared the dueling leaders and drew clear driving. TOP BOSS prompted ATTA BOY PETE from the inside, challenged on the turn, led in the upper stretch but proved no match for the winner. IMA KOOL STAR broke out, bumped with CAYOKEY'S WISH and stumbled sharply to lose eight lengths at the start then raced unhurried, split PRINCE O MINE and REALMENTE PRIVADO at the quarter pole, angled out for the drive and finished willingly. CAHILL CHROME settled early with striking distance then saved ground to no avail. ATTA BOY PETE was fractious warming up and unseated his rider twice but broke alertly to set the pace from off the rail into the stretch then had little left. PRINCE O' MINE was forwardly placed outside early but faded from the four path on the turn. CAYOKEY'S WISH was bumped at the start and then was outrun. SOUTH FORTY had no speed. REALMENTE PRIVADO settled early and gave way inside on the turn. LONE JACK MINE was never a factor.
