### Footnotes

WELCOME HOME RYAN was not asked for speed early while four wide to the backstretch, moved closer into the second turn, offered a bold rally three wide to the stretch, gained command inside the furlong pole and edged clear driving. HE'S CAGEY settled early rail, remained inside on the second turn while moving with the winner, finished steadily but could not match strides with that rival. COACH BOB set a pressured pace from the outset, shook loose of RED COATS R COMIN entering the lane to gain a clear lead but lacked the needed response leaving the furlong pole. LODI RED settled early three wide, was two wide on the second turn and came on late without being a serious threat. MAYBE TUESDAY lagged early from off the rail, tried to rally three wide behind the winner on the second turn but could not advance. SAMMARTINO saved ground throughout and finished in only a mild rally. PEPNIC was void of early speed, came three wide to the stretch but lacked the needed response. RED COATS R COMIN prompted COACH BOB for six furlongs and stopped. GUMMY RUNNER was finished after a half mile.
