MEMPHIS MOBSTER broke in stride and dueled two wide early, disposed of OHSOKOOL at mid turn but met a bid from FROM HERE TO THERE, edged clear of that rival nearing the furlong pole and held driving. FROM HERE TO THERE stalked the winner from the outside, had his best bid at the quarter pole but could not match strides in the lane. WOODPULP lagged early, came through inside on the turn and upper stretch to loom a factor but lost his punch. DEEJENERIT stalked the pace from the inside early, eased two wide on the turn and went evenly through the lane. GOLDEN WARRIOR settled early, came three wide on the turn and weakened. CIMMARON KID lacked good early speed, was fanned four wide on the turn and failed to reach contention. OHSOKOOL broke a step slow but was quickly in stride to duel inside the winner to mid turn and gave out.
