Footnotes

BONFANTE stalked the pace inside to the turn, saw an opening inside and accelerated quickly to bid for the lead to the stretch, was clear to mid stretch then was all out to hold. FLYING SUPERCON was quickest early and set the pace under pressure to the turn, was slightly off the rail which allowed the winner an opening, had that one bolt by him into the stretch but continued to do battle to the wire in a game try. KOOL SUGGESTION chased the leaders to the turn, was forced to circle five wide into the stretch and had a mild late bid. R. BAGGIO had no speed, was steered outside horses, came four wide to the stretch then finished full of run. MY CAPTAIN was allowed to settle to the turn, raced two deep to the stretch but lacked the needed late response. TRICKEY TREVOR was in contention from the outset, prompted the pace three wide to the stretch but had little left when roused. DEBONAIR JOE saved ground to no avail. ONEBADSHARK pressed the pace early, got fanned four wide to the stretch and gave out in the final furlong.
