Footnotes

COME HOME SWEETIE broke in stride and dueled outside GOOD TIMES TWEENUS into the stretch, disposed of that rival to draw clear but just did last. RUCKUSING STORM was not asked for speed early, shifted off the rail once on the turn to rally two wide into the lane, lacked a clear path and waited briefly for room near the furlong pole, came through between SMART SUGAR and LONELY AND FREE just past the furlong pole and closed with a rush to just miss. SMART SUGAR settled early but was always within striking distance, came three wide to the stretch, shifted out further for a clear path and finished steadily. COURT BENCH lagged early, raced four wide on the turn and finished steadily. HAMMETT STAR was permitted to settle early, saved ground on the turn then came on. LONELY AND FREE stalked the winner from the four path into the stretch and weakened. HI FLYIN STORM raced close up early but failed to respond while two wide into the lane. GOOD TIMES TWEENUS dueled from the rail to the head of the lane and gave out.
