Footnotes

FISHIN WITH T BALL set the pace to the turn, turned back OUR STARDUST to the stretch, edged clear to mid stretch then was tiring in the final sixteenth and held to a desperate decision. WARM HANDS was outsprinted to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch then rallied smartly in the final furlong, surged at the winner in the final strides and just missed. OUR STARDUST pressed the pace to the turn, offered her best bid two wide to the stretch, was turned back and outkicked to mid stretch then finished evenly. P TOWN TOPPER had no speed, raced in the two path on the turn, angled out for room in upper stretch and closed willingly in the late stages. LA CUBANITA chased the winner to the turn, came three wide to the stretch and was closing ground to the wire. ONE FOR THE MONEY had no speed, raced four wide to the stretch then eased widest in upper stretch and was also closing the gap. CASTILLON had no speed, tried to rally from the two path to the stretch then was gaining late without being a serious threat. SWEET SILENCE raced mid pack to the turn then saved ground but failed to threaten. BROKEN FEVER also chased the pace from the two path to the stretch then gave out.
