BELS DREAM CASTLE settled early from off the rail, set out after the leaders three wide on the second turn, collared CHEESEWRIGHT late and edged clear driving. CHEESEWRIGHT stumbled at the start, recovered and pulled to the lead, set all of the pace from the inside to the furlong pole then could not match strides with the winner. MARK A STAR lagged early, saved ground throughout and lacked the needed rally. EXCESSIVE FASHION stalked the pace three wide, had a brief bid after a half two wide and slackened. MISSBELLEO'S CAUSE settled from the inside but came up empty when called upon and was eased but walked off. ARISAIL stalked the pace three wide, stopped and was eased in the stretch but walked off.
