Footnotes

CHILE DE ORO was sent to the front soon after the start, set the pace from just off the rail to the stretch, responded to urging in the drive and held gamely. TRICKY MANDATE tracked the leaders early, got shuffled back at the three eighths, remained inside and was checked off heels into the stretch then could not get through inside the winner in mid stretch, was angled out and finished gamely. ONEBADJOE had no speed, was roused three wide to the stretch then finished well through the final furlong. PIMIENTO NEGRO prompted the pace while off the rail to the stretch, loomed a threat a furlong out then could not muster the needed response. RAPID RETURN had no speed, raced three deep on the turn then finished willingly through the lane. A. J. DA SKIPPER stalked the pace early, got fanned four wide to the stretch and could not make an impact through the drive. REPEATED N RED had no speed, also was four wide on the turn and was gaining ground belatedly. BUCKSHOT BOB was a pace factor three wide to the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. INDIGLO was outsprinted, eased over to save ground on the turn but gave way in the drive.
