SELECTOR was hustled briefly from the gate to establish command, drew well clear on the turn without need of urging and maintained his advantage through the drive to win with speed to spare. UNBRIDLED STAR was never too far back, tried to rally three wide into the lane but could not threaten the winner. OLD MILLWAKIE broke slow, advanced quickly three wide on the turn but raced evenly late. GOLDEN TRIP lacked the needed response. AN ELEGANT POINT saved ground and failed to rally. STYLISH STORM showed little. BREAKFAST KLUG stalked the winner inside to the quarter pole and gave out. WORTH IT had no rally while four wide on the turn. MAJESTIC SPLENDOR showed little. TRINITY TREASURE was outrun.
