YEREVAN STAR broke alertly and dueled for the lead inside of FRISCO SLEW to the stretch, put that one away but had to contend with STRUT YOUR STUFF and was headed in mid stretch, then fought back gamely to prevail. STRUT YOUR STUFF broke a bit tardy then moved smoothly past horses to track the leaders to the turn, rallied three wide to the stretch, moved to the lead at the furlong pole, could not shake the winner through the drive and was headed on the wire. TRAVEL POSTCARD had no speed, raced mid pack to the turn, steadied off heels at the three eighths, rallied two wide to the stretch then was no threat while gaining the show. FRISCO SLEW broke well and angled over quickly, dueled for the lead two wide to the stretch but tired in the drive. PENNY ANTE was allowed to settle to the turn, got caught four wide to the stretch then lacked a closing response. BOLD MYSTIQUE hesitated and was off slow, advanced along the rail to get into contention, checked inside nearing the three eighths then weakened through the stretch. A GIRL NAMED PHIL tracked the pace three wide to the stretch then lacked a rally. LUKE'S FINEST had no speed, got fanned four wide to the stretch but came up empty. SUZY O'BRIEN saved ground to no avail. TYCHONICS MISTRESS stalked the pace to the turn then gave out.
