Footnotes

PRINCESS HIAWATHA was permitted to settle in mid pack early from off the rail, dropped inside on the second turn to rally into the stretch, shifted back outside FLIRT WITH JUSTICE leaving the furlong pole, rallied willingly and was up in the final stride. FLIRT WITH JUSTICE set all of the pace from the inside but just off the rail, edged clear in the upper stretch then could not quite hold off the winner. POWEROFVOODOO raced unhurried while four wide to the backstretch, moved closer into the second turn but remained four wide and finished steadily. DIXIELAND CLASSIC tracked the pace from the inside to the second turn, angled three wide at the quarter pole but lost his punch. CLASSIC DEMAND pressed the pace two wide into the stretch and gave way. DA HEAT was void of any early speed, tried to rally three wide on the second turn but lacked the needed response. KEIRA'S WAY showed little. COMMENDABLE QUEEN was never a factor. PAPRIKA RED prompted the pace three wide to the second turn and game up empty.
