WHOS CALLING NOW never far back to the half mile pole, rallied three wide and between rivals on the second turn, was up to duel the runnerup through the final furlong and bested that one gamely. ADDISON was well placed to the second turn, rallied four wide to engage for the lead to mid stretch, stuck a head in front nearing the sixteenth marker but hung late. ENDLESS SWEEP tracked the leader to the half, was fanned five wide while trying to rally on the second turn but lost her punch in the drive. LARLA sped clear on the first turn, set the pace while off the rail to the second turn but tired after six furlongs and gave way in the stretch. KRISTENS CAT had no speed and was not a factor. LIVING LEGEND was three wide early, settled to the second turn then lacked a response when called up two deep on the second turn. BEST OF THE BUNCH was through early.
