ROOSTER CITY chased the leaders to the turn, rallied three wide and closed well to loom boldly a furlong out then was outfinished. SCOFIELD BARRACKS had no speed, got fanned four wide while rallying on the turn, also loomed a threat a furlong out but lost his punch in the late stages. WHATSTHESCRIP (IRE) lagged to the turn, saved ground while closing to the stretch then finished willingly under steady urging. GOGGLES MCCOY was part of the hot pace with the winner to mid turn then was outrun by that one to the stretch and gave way.
