**Footnotes**

A LITTLE POLISH pulled to the front soon after the start without any urging, set all the pace and was never threatened. CLEAR IMAGINE raced in the middle of the pack to the turn, rallied four wide and closed with interest without impacting the outcome. EAST FORK hustled to a short lead soon after the start, pressured the winner to the turn and weakened in the stretch. A YEAR OFTHE COINS raced in the middle of the field and did not rally. STAR'S ASCENT did not menace in a rail trip and finished evenly. JAN THE FIRST showed little. SCARLETT'S MARK could not keep up. FAYLEENE showed speed to the stretch and had no further response when asked.
